The Inspector General of Police in Uganda, Mr. Oryema paid his respects to Baba that morning and was very happy to receive blessings and signs of grace from Baba.



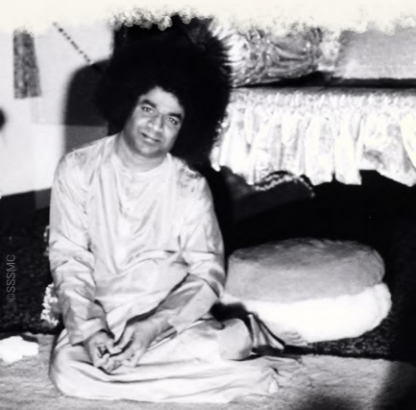


**The Chief of Staff of the Uganda Army,
