Departure From Wilson Airport To Entebbe, Kampala

July 05, 1968





Swami and His party drove to Wilson airport, Nairobi from Nanyuki, and boarded the chartered plane to Kampala. Flying over the rift valley, the famous Kenya highlands, and over the harbour town of Kisumu, they reached Entebbe.





Swami emphasized to devotees the importance of discipline and advised them not to break any rules in rushing to Him.





Swami had spent 50 hours away from Kampala and was to return to India on July 10, 1968. Devotees handed many letters to Him on the theme, "Father, do not leave us". Swami sent a message to India through a cable that the return was postponed!





When someone remarked that the Sai family now included many Africans, Swami responded thus, *“Do not tell Me of a new Sai family; I am Sanathana (Ancient, Eternal) come as Nutana (New). Shall I tell you who the constituents of the Sai family are? The family of every Sai devotee? His father, Truth; his mother, Love; his wife or her husband, Detachment; his son, Wisdom; his daughter, Fortitude; his kith and kin, the Good; his friends and companions, the sages and saints – such is the Sai family.”*
