Later talking to Patel's family in the evening, Swami said, *"Men are like flint; it has latent heat; when it strikes against another flint, sparks emanate, and they can be fed until a big fire is caused. The second flint is usually some calamity or loss or disappointment. Prosperity deadens the intellect while failure prompts enquiry and the struggle to remove hardships forever."*
